
Every panchayat in India will join in offering collective tribute to the MITTI OF THE MOTHERLAND (2.5 lakh+)

MITTI YATRAS FROM PANCHAYAT-BLOCK-DELHI 7500 kalash of mitti will come to Delhi

Program at Kartavya Path in Delhi with 7500 Youth representing each block.

Elements of the panchayat level programme



Programs may be executed across all panchayats/villages.

Mitti from nearby villages may be brought and made part of panchayat level programmes.

Deep Dive : Silaphalakam





- In each panchayat/village memorial plaque of approx. 5 feet by 3 feet proposed to be erected. (In case any specific space considerations ratio of 5:3 may be maintained and size scaled accordingly.)
- Memorial plaque to be constructed in/around Amrit Sarovars, water bodies where available and near water bodies panchayat office, schools etc. where water bodies are not available.
- Work may be executed through MGNREGA leveraging local material and resources.
- Base artwork to be available on campaign website for reference.
- Print file option would be auto generated for download basis inputs. (Panchayat name)




- Where names of local veers are not available/ applicable generic dedication to be used
- Downloadable artwork to include AKAM logo/ AKAM 2047 vision (Quote)/ Name of Panchayat and Date
- Names of veers to be added locally. Open file would be made available.
- More than 1 shilaphalakam may be erected as per requirement.






Design with names

Logins to be created as per requirement.




An interactive map feature will be integrated into the webpage, specifically designed to display the location of the Amrit Vatikas.

- 75 indigenous saplings to be planted at each event across
 2.5 lakh + panchayats of India.
- Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change coordinating and steering the overall plantation related activities. States and UTs to align and sync with these efforts.
- State Nodal District collector to ensure sapling purchase centers identified locally in coordination with Forest/Horticulture Departments.
- Amrit Vatika to be created.

- These would include
 - Living freedom fighters and families of deceased freedom fighters
 - Retired & deceased personnel from Defence, Central Armed Police
 Force and State Police Force.
- Families of freedom fighters/ veers to be invited.
- Felicitation to be done as per local custom and tradition.



First level of programmes to be held in the small Urban Local bodies, NAC, Cantonment Board, Town Panchayats etc.

Second level programmes at larger Municipalities and Municipal Corporations

Feed into finale event at the National Capital.

- Mitti yatras to be undertaken from smaller urban bodies to larger municipalities and corporations and onwards to Delhi.
- Ceremonial mitti kalash to be accorded due respect and reverence and made a prominent part of programme.

- Take mutthi bhar mitti and offer their respect by lighting a mitti diya dedicated to bravehearts/ veer who made our freedom possible and upload mitti pranam selfies on campaign website.
- While uploading on website they would digitally take the Panch Pran pledge and promise to commit to nation building by just clicking on the 'I Promise' button on the website.



Institution	Mandate	
Panchayats	 Outreach sessions with heads of panchayats essential at the level of concerned departments. Sapling distribution / sales points to be identified in each village. Self Help Groups to be leveraged : mitti diyas, kalash All Government buildings, institutions to be decorated, employees take Panch Pran pledge. Local leaders to participate. 	
Housing and Urban Development	 Outreach sessions with urban local bodies Sapling distribution / sales points to be identified in each location. Outreach with market associations etc. Branding at strategic locations. All Government buildings, institutions to be decorated, employees take Panch Pran pledge. Local leaders to participate. 	
Fair Price Shops	 Vast network to be leveraged as distribution/sales point for the mitti diyas. Pre recorded messages, jingles, info on programme may be played on mics in and around these shops Scannable standees around shops linking to campaign website. People to take the pledge, upload selfies. 	



Institution	Mandate
Schools & Colleges	 Special assemblies dedicated to the MERI MAATI MERA DESH to be held. Students and teachers to take the Panch Pran pledge, upload selfies. Special diary note, leaflet to be sent to all parents for participation. Schools to felicitate local bravehearts/veers.
Police	 DG Police to take special meeting about the programme. Check points to have programme posters. Special MERI MAATI MERA DESH marches to be conducted. Police stations : exhibit banners, posters, standees, take the Panch Pran pledge, upload selfies. Honoring and felicitations of veers. Programmes may be held in local schools & colonies to increase outreach.
Transport	 State transport buses, trucks, autos to be painted with messages about MERI MAATI MERA DESH Toll and check points to be branded, distribute pamphlets, leaflets etc. Inter State buses with intercom & video systems to play jingles, recorded messages, Mitti Anthem, show video snippets related to bravehearts etc.

Media	 All State Government websites to carry banners linking to campaign website – MERI MAATI MERA DESH Special media briefings, press briefs to be done about plan of action at State and district level. DD, AIR special bulletins. Local PIB officers to ensure good coverage and spotlighting of all efforts. Backstories, human interest stories related to bravehearts / unsung heroes, patriotism to be generated. Wall paintings and Rangolis to be created at all public spots with high footfalls. Panchayat offices, government schools and centers to have banners and standees of the campaign (creatives can be downloaded from the website) Hoardings, banners and standees at the local municipality spots/public spots/ Govt. buildings. Government banks, postal offices and milk centers to have banners and standees.
