Action Plan for "Har Ghar Tiranga" programme Department of Youth Affairs

The 'Har Ghar Tiranga' programme envisages to inspire Indians everywhere to hoist/display the national flag at their workplace and homes. The Department of Youth Affairs will undertake this Programme to invoke feelings of patriotism in the hearts of the people and encourage people to hoist/display the Indian National Flag with pride.

2. While displaying/hoisting, utmost care shall be taken by all to uphold the dignity and honour of the National Flag in accordance with the provisions of the Flag Code of India, 2002 and the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971.

Department of Youth Affairs (Secretariat):

- 1. National Flag will be hoisted at the office premises.
- 2. National Flag will be displayed by all officers/employees at their working desk in their respective offices.
- 3. The family members of all officers/employees will hoist/display the National Flag at their homes and in the neighbourhood.
- 4. The officers/employees will popularize the Programme amongst their relatives/acquaintances the through their social media accounts to motivate the people for hoisting the National Flag at their homes.

II. Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and Rajiv Gandhi and National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD):

- 1. Utilizing the NYKS and RGNIYD website to promote the "Har GharTiranga" Programme.
- Popularizing the https://amritmahotsav.nic.in/har-ghar-tiranga.htm portal among public and Youth In particular while organizing Core and Special programmes of NYKS and RGNIYD.
- 3. "Did You Know" series on Social Medial handles of NYKS and RGNIYD on the facts about National Flag.
- Including "Har Ghar Tiranga" as a discussion topic in on-going programmes of NYKS and RGNIYD.
- 5. Sharing of "Flag Code of India 2002" among National Youth Volunteers and Youth Clubs Members to generate awareness about the flag code in their localities/villages/panchayats and towns.
- 6. Encouraging the Youth to hoist the National Flag at their home during all national significant days by following all requisite protocols.
- 7. Knowledge Competition such as Flag Quiz, Painting Competition etc to raise awareness about the importance of National Flag of India.
- 8. Organizing skits, street plays to popularize about the importance of National Flag of India

- 9. The National Flag of India will be displayed in all the programs of RGNIYD
- 10. All the Officials of RGNIYD will host the National Flag in their homes and in their official quarters during all national significant days by following all requisite protocols.

III. National Service Scheme (NSS):

- 1. National Flag will be hoisted by all Regional Directorates of NSS at their Office Premises in various states.
- 2. National Flag will be displayed by all employees of NSS at their working desk in their respective offices.
- 3. Awareness will be created by all employees of NSS among their family members and neighbors to display the National Flag at their homes.
- Awareness will be created by all Regional Directorates through their official social media handles to motivate the people for hoisting the National Flag at their homes.
