Background

- Indian Constitution is the most important guiding document of Indian Democracy. It enables a
 common man to know the fundamental rights and duties of a Citizen. Besides, it also tells us as
 to what constitutes to become a Productive and Responsible Citizen.
- The constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution on 26th November, 1949 which became effective on 26th January, 1950. Constitution Day or Samvidhan Diwas in India therefore is celebrated every year on 26th November to honour and remember the father of Constitution Dr B R Ambedkar; and to spread the importance of the Constitution of India and how it is helpful towards the growth and development of the country.
- It has been found that the knowledge and information among Millennial about Indian Constitution and its salient features are at sub-optimal level. They can only become law abiding and conscious of their rights as well as duties, if they are properly oriented about the basic tenets and spirit of Indian Constitution and also engaging them in the propagation of awareness on Constitution among their peer groups.

In view of the above, NYKS proposes Celebration of Constitution Day on 26th November, 2019 and subsequent activities culminating in Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti(27th November2019 to 14th April2020) across the country through the instrumentalities of District NYKs and their affiliated Village based Youth Clubs.
